
Bicycling and Busing to the Events

Shuttle Service to the Festival

There is no event parking in the Lake Calhoun Executive Center parking lot and parking options around the Loppet Festival area are extremely limited. However, the Loppet Foundation will be running a convenient and free shuttle bus from the Walker Library (Lagoon and Lake Street) to the Loppet Festival Area. Buses will run Friday from 6 - 9 p.m., Saturday from 10 a.m. - 10 p.m. and Sunday from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. Park on city streets near the Walker Library, at Jefferson Elementary at 26th and Hennepin, or in the Mosaic or Calhoun Square parking ramps. Free parking and a shuttle bus are also available in the


