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All groups need to understand and agree to follow these rules of the MPRB Trails.

- Facilities, Buses & Parking
  - All buses will drop off in the Wirth Chalet parking lot only. A parking lot map is available. Buses are not allowed to remain in the parking lots at Wirth.
  - Limited indoor space is available. Fire Code Restrictions will be enforced.
  - Waxing is not allowed inside buildings.
- Ski Passes, Trails & Group Skiing
  - We understand that every skier and coach/leader is required to purchase a ski pass and have it visible at all times while on the MPRB trail system.
  - We understand that when skiing in premium snow areas (snowmaking trails) all participants in our group will follow the rules of the trails, including skiing continuously in the correct direction, not walking on the trails, and not stopping to coach.
  - Teaching Areas & Events We understand that our Trail Passes entitle us to use the trails for skiing only. Trail Passes do not entitle us to conduct races or coaching activities on the trails. For those activities we acknowledge that a special use permit is required. Coaching is to happen in designated teaching areas only. We understand that failure to secure a permit for races or coaching may result in the revocation of our passes and/or the loss of reduced-price pass privileges in future years.

Applicants assume all responsibility for and hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Loppet Foundation and/or the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board against any losses, damages, liabilities, action suits, proceedings, costs or expenses that the Loppet Foundation or the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board may incur or sustain or for which it may become liable (including, but not limited to, personal and bodily injury to, or death of, persons or damage to property) resulting or arising from the permitted event. The obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the Loppet Foundation or the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board will survive the termination or expiration of the agreement.
