



The Loppet Foundation is looking for an energetic, experienced individual to instruct youth -- ages 8 - 13 -- in the sport of archery at our Adventure Camps for summer 2020! Adventure Camp is the centerpiece of the Loppet Foundation's summer programming offered to the general community, and, accordingly, we are seeking an organized, driven candidate who embodies the spirit of our mission: to get underserved people outdoors and active.

As Archery Instructor, you will be principally responsible for the safety, skill-development, and enjoyment of the sport of archery at Adventure Camps. You will teach the sport to groups of 10 youth, with 2 counselors to assist in running an effective program.

We ask that applicants for the Mountain Bike Instructor position commit to work 6 of the following sessions of Adventure Camp:

Week I June 15 - 19	Week II June 22 - 26	Week III July 6 - 10	Week IV July 13 - 17
Week V July 20 - 24	Week VI July 27 - 31	Week VII August 3 - 7	Week VIII August 10 - 14

Archery will be a part-time position at Adventure Camp this year. The exact hours and days that will constitute this position will be to-be-determined, but it will be approximately 24 hours / week.

Requirements:

- Be at least 16 years old;
- Have experience with archery, *particularly* with the instruction of archery technique and skills;
- Be Red Cross CPR / First Aid certified; and
- Complete both HeadsUp Concussion and SafeSport Coaching trainings.
