Job Summary: This role works with the LEAP Land Use committee as well as our habitat restoration consultants from NatureWerks, to plan for and lead volunteer habitat restoration events.

Habitat Restoration Lead is responsible for the following:

- Work with the LEAP Land Use Committee on planning, organization and coordination of Tuesday evening volunteer habitat restoration events.
- Step in as lead for some Tuesday evening volunteer habitat restoration events. This includes:
 - Sending reminder/details email to registered participants the morning prior to event
 - Gathering tools, gloves, snacks, signage for the night and putting away when done.
 - Facilitating the event but greeting volunteers, engaging throughout, and providing some knowledge and plan for the evening
 - Communicating after the event what was worked on/accomplished
- Possibly coordinate and lead other habitat restoration volunteer events outside of Tuesday evenings.
